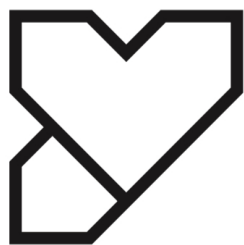

## IT'S TIME FOR ANOTHER TEAM FUNDRAISER!



This year, our lively and youthful team of youth workers are plagued with dodgy knees and bad backs, so we've decided to split into two teams and race each other to the base of Snowdon.

On Saturday 15th March, Team 1 will be hiking up and down Snowdon as quickly as they can,

whilst Team 2 will be cycling along the North Wales Coastal Path in an effort to reach Snowdon before Team 1 complete their hike. **Why, I hear you ask?**

Well, in the first term of this school year, we delivered nearly 200 one-to-one mentoring sessions, and have seen over 120 young people attending Christian clubs in local high schools and churches - the majority of whom are completely unchurched. They come and bring their questions, thoughts, doubts, and experiences, and our aim is to be there for them and meet them exactly where they are, sharing with them the acceptance, love, and hope that can be found in Jesus.

It's for this reason that taking on fundraising challenges is so important to us as a team, because it's only by your generous donations that we can offer free youth workers to high schools across Warrington.
