“ This month sees my first year with Warrington Youth for Christ complete and God has already done so much. It’s exciting to think about the year to come being even more blessed.

The new drop-in has launched in Penketh in conjunction with detached work, and we have seen over 70 young people! We’ve had the opportunity to engage in deep and meaningful conversations which has been amazing.

In Penketh High, I have been able to get alongside some of the students that struggle in Religious Studies and Personal Development, building up favour with the school and staff. Fresh after-school club has also been consisting running with a core group of 5 young people.

Over in the Town Centre, I am getting directly involved in the curriculum at UTC - getting alongside the school planning trips to churches, inviting church leaders in, and connecting with the Food Bank and Community Grocery.

There have been some fantastic opportunities opened up to work closer with several churches in the town centre after very productive and encouraging meetings - not just on the work, but hearing the heart of the church as well to see God’s kingdom come.
