We had an action-packed month which involved sharing the good news of Easter with 600 young people in Boteler's Easter Service, as well as taking our Academy away on a residential. Our Latchford worker Kim shares more...

"We want to involve young people in the mission to reach young people, and that's what our Academy is all about. Young people from across Warrington at various points in their faith journey can come together and explore what it means to follow Jesus as a teenager in 2023 and share his love with others.

The residential was an opportunity to walk through the Easter story together in creative ways, engaging with the impact that Jesus' death on the cross has on our lives today, how we can experience Jesus walking with us in difficult circumstances, and how his resurrection gives us new life.

As well as having lots of space to connect with God in different ways, the residential was a great opportunity for the young people to spend time together, deepen their friendships, and pray for one another. We also explored evangelism and different ways we can reach people with the good news as we plan a programme of events for the summer.
