“ Every Friday evening, our staff workers deliver outreach in many forms. Historically detached work has been the normative approach in which a member of our team partners with volunteers from the local church. They reach the young people in our communities 'where they are at', on the streets and parks, with the gospel message.

In recent years our approach has diversified with the delivery of Tea & Toast drop-ins, Youth Street Tent, Football Cage, Sports outreach, and even detached work in the new town centre Youth Zone facility, all with the one aim of making Jesus known in these contexts.

There isn't the time or space here to tell of the many stories of breakthrough that I could mention resulting from Friday night outreach, but one does spring to mind.

Jack (not his real name) attended a youth drop-in and was subsequently invited to a local church youth group where he began to attend.

He was then invited by them to Limitless, a large Christian youth festival, and it had a massive impact on him, leading to him having a powerful experience of the presence of God in his heart during a time of worship. He invited his sister to the festival, who gave her heart and life to Jesus in response to the gospel message shared that evening. Both of them now attend the church youth group and are experiencing the wonders of being disciples of Jesus, and making new friends in the family of God.

We love reaching young people for Jesus and seeing them come right through into discipleship. We could not do this without you - those of you who stand with us financially, prayerfully, and volunteer in these many contexts. You are such a blessing. Thank-you!"
